What You Will Receive

As the surviving spouse of the Veteran, you are entitled to receive the Veteran's benefit for the month in which they died. We will soon send you a check for the month of the Veteran's death in the amount of

You are also entitled to receive burial benefits to help cover costs for the Veteran's funeral. Because the Veteran was in receipt of service-connected disability compensation, VA will soon send you a check in the amount of to help cover the cost of the Veteran's funeral.

If you do not believe we are paying you the correct amount, you should write and tell us why. You have one year from the date of this letter to appeal our decision to pay you these amounts. The enclosed VA Form 4107, Your Rights to Appeal Our Decision, explains your right to appeal.

Where to Return Payments Issued After the Veteran's Death?

If any VA payments were issued in the Veteran's name after the date of death, they must be returned. If you still have any uncashed US Treasury checks made payable to the Veteran, they should be returned to Department of Treasury at the following address:
