**AMMENDED AFFIDAVIT OF WARRANTLESS ARREST**

The undersigned, of lawful age, being first duly sworn, upon oath deposes and states as follows:

1. He is an Peace Officer with the Panama Police Department.
2. He has read certain official investigative reports and statements of witnesses regarding the above named Defendant and, from these statements and reports it appears as follows:

On 11/22/2017 at approximately 0210 I , Sgt. Mark Jiminez, was on routine patrol in the town of Panama. I observed a silver Lexus bearing OK BOQ058 parked in the outside lane of the southbound side of US highway 59. The car was north of the intersection of US 59 and Edmond Street. I observed a white male wearing shorts and a short sleeved shirt walking south away from the vehicle. I pulled my patrol car alongside him and made contact with the individual later identified as Steven Minks. I asked Minks if the silver Lexus was his car. He shrugged his shoulders and asked if he was under arrest. I advised him I just needed to know if that was his vehicle in the highway as it was blocking travel. I asked if it had broken down and he asked if he had done anything wrong or broke the law and continued walking. He asked if he was under arrest and I advised him no he wasn't. He then stated "Bye" and kept walking. I continued to drive alongside him trying to communicate with him. He became agitated and stated to fuck off. He then asked if I liked being sued and waved and stated "bye" again. I asked him to identify himself and he again asked if he was under arrest. I then pulled past him and exited my vehicle to the sidewalk. As he approached I asked him why he was so agitated and he continued walking. I advised him that I was detaining him until I could figure out what was going on with him. I patted him for weapons and at this time noticed a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage on or about his person and blood shot eyes. He called me a bitch and told me he was suing me. I then advised him he was under arrest for public intoxication. I grasp both arms and put them behind his back. I was able to cuff his right arm but before I could cuff the left he abruptly jerked it back to his front. I told him that he did not want to do that

and he advised that he did want to. Shady Point officer Atkins had arrived to assist and Minks was placed into his patrol car because it has a cage. Officer Atkins ran the tag on the Lexus and it belonged to Minks. Upon inventory prior to the wrecker arrival Officer Atkins located a loaded smith and Wesson .380 caliber pistol in the vehicle.

The above events occurred in the County of LeFlore, State of Oklahoma.
